The Office of the Undersecretary for Urban Poor, Informal Settler Families and other Special Concerns of the DILG invites interested applicants as **Community Mobilizers (CMs)** for its Grassroots Planning and Budgeting Program (GPBP) and Civil Society Empowerment Program (CSEP). The GPB and CSEP programs will require 165 CMs who will be deployed in the different cities and municipalities nationwide.

In general, the tasks and function of the CMs is to ensure the implementation of the grassroots planning and budgeting process as indicated in the Joint Memorandum Circular and facilitate civil society participation in local governance.

The applicant must have the following qualifications:

Education: Graduate of any 4 year course relevant to social development, community development, and/or social work. Undergraduates who possess at least 3 years experience in community development, social work, and participatory local governance may also be considered.

Training: Should preferably have (40) hours of relevant training in community organizing, community mobilization strategies and approaches, social development and/or Popular Education techniques and approaches.

Experience: at least 1 year of relevant, progressive work experience in community organizing and/or social development work. Experience in Participatory Local Governance will be an advantage.

Other qualifications: Must have a strong sense of social responsibility, credible/able to work with Civil Society Organizations and local government units, able to communicate verbally and in writing to various stakeholders, be fluent in the local dialect and/or a resident of the area to which he or she will be assigned and computer literate.
